## Parking at Gorgie

**Parking for families, elderly and disabled at Springwell House (see map below):**

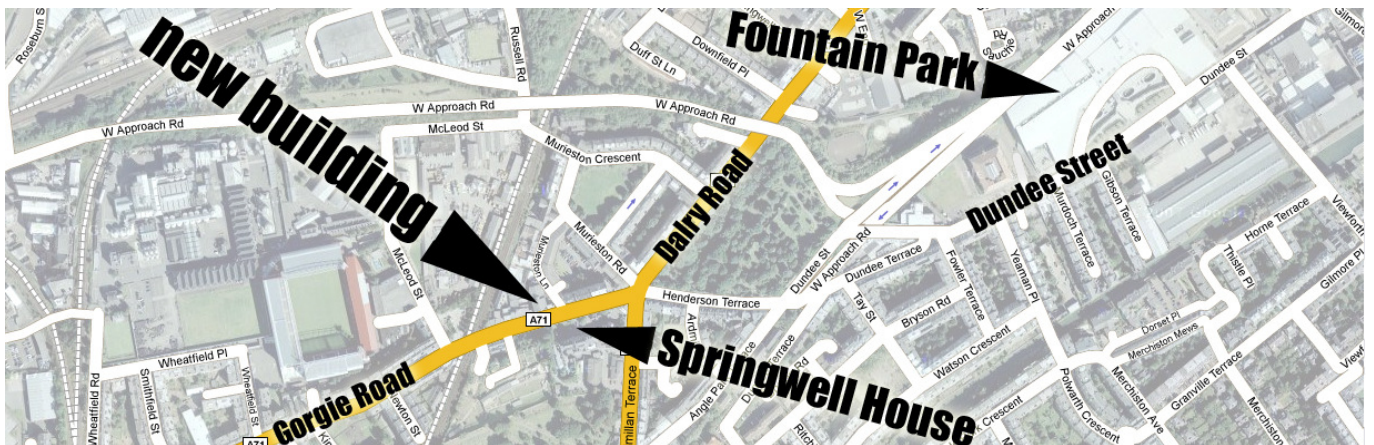
Across from the entrance to our Gorgie building there is an opening into a car park in the grounds of Springwell House. This parking is free and open to the public at the weekends. We would ask that this be reserved for families, elderly and the disabled.

**Free on street parking:**

Many of the residential streets off Gorgie Road have free parking, especially as you head away out of town. In McLeod Street especially there will be a good number of free spaces (this is the street that passes the front of Tynecastle high school & stadium). Avoid "permit holders only" spaces as you could get a parking fine if parked there. Also we would ask that you avoid parking in the private resident's car park in Murieston Lane at the side of our building, this would be unfair on the residents.

**Car park at Fountain Park (see map below):**

Fountain Park is only a 5 min walk away from the Gorgie building. It has an covered car park which you pay to park in. However you can park for free there if you have lunch, go to the cinema or use any of the other facilities in the Fountain Park complex. ## Public transport to Gorgie

Buses 2, 3/3A, 25, 33 stop outside Gorgie Farm, this is directly opposite the building.

Buses 4, 44 stop on Ardmillan Terrace which is just round the corner from the building.
